The brambles need strimming back on Diamond Bank – R.Lowson will deal with this c. There is still a stone missing on the bridge near the junction of the road to Butterknowle, on the B6282. Grid ref 117257 d. There are still a table and chairs in situ at the temporary accommodation at the bottom of the Slack e. On footpath 72 there are no signs to indicate the footpath, there is a gate obstructing the path and vehicles parked in the area. To be reported to Pewter Crinnion f. A hole has appeared in the verge between the junction of Southside and Quarry Lane, opp 3rd telegraph pole along. g. The fence and concrete pillar has not been repaired O/s 36 The Slack Butterknowle h. The dolomite at the side of the cattle grid – closest to Butterknowle, is still spilling over onto the road – it needs to be hardened down i.
